Tent of Nations

As a District, we were privileged to hear Daoud Nassar of the Tent of Nations on Mon 22nd Sept by Zoom and in person at Hapton Methodist Church. The Nassar family received the Methodist Peace Award in 2017.

Daoud shared the powerful story of their educational, ecological farm, surrounded by 5 Illegal settlements. We saw and heard how the farm stands as a statement of resilience and nonviolent resistance. A humbling story to listen to, of the family's Faith, courage and unwavering commitment to justice based on their motto 'We refuse to be Enemies'.

As church leaders and the Methodist Church in the UK, Daoud emphasized the importance for the need to advocate for the Tent of Nations and speak out at the political level, encourage official church delegations and church members to visit the Tent of Nations if they plan a trip to the Holy Land. International presence is the only remaining protection for the Tent of Nations.
