Comfort those who mourn and bring peace to those in distress.


We offer our prayer in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour.

#### Message from the Circuit Superintendent

Dear Friends,

On Friday we woke up to a changed country following the death of her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II the day before.

Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth is for many of us the only Queen we have ever known, and it seems strange to think that she is no longer with us. Many of us have felt a profound sense of loss that has taken us by surprise and over the coming days we will remember the Queen in our own ways.

Much has been said about Elizabeth II, about her dedication to duty, both here in the UK and throughout the Commonwealth. She promised at the age of 21 to devote her life to service and has kept that promise throughout her long life.

I think for me what stood out most about the late Queen was her strong Christian faith, the faith that sustained her throughout her life and faith she wasn't afraid to speak about publicly and share with others. I believe it was her Christian faith that made her the successful and hardworking Head of State that she was. I was very moved when I found out she would sometimes sign her letters "your servant Elizabeth R", an attitude that surely extended from her Christian discipleship and her recognition that whilst she was Queen, Jesus is King of Kings (and Queens).

On Saturday a new King, Charles III, started his service as our Monarch: but for him and the Royal family that meant of course grieving for a dearly loved mother, grandmother, great grandmother, and aunt. Like any grieving family they need our prayers.

We need to pray for each other, too, as we come to terms with what will be a significant change in our country and as we mourn Queen Elizabeth II.

As a Circuit we will be holding a short service of Prayer and Reflection on Zoom this coming Thursday at 7:30pm, led by myself, Tony and Richard, a chance to gather together and bring to God some of our thoughts and feelings at this historic time of change.
