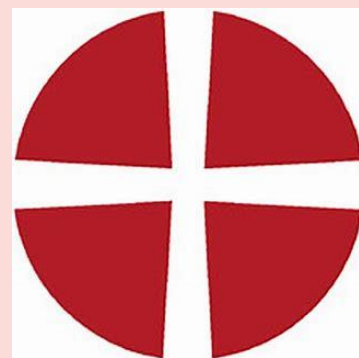

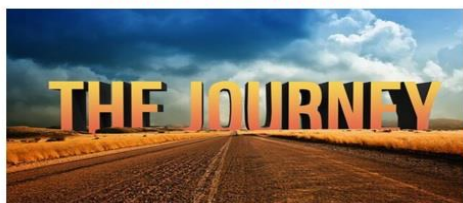
Update on Ukraine appeal.

This week another van load of much needed items from the Circuit to the International Aid Trust depot in Preston has been delivered. These items will travel out to the Ukraine later this week. To date over 320 tons of aid has been sent from this one depot, Now the Trust is able to purchase supplies at the borders of Ukraine and they have got an extra 3 second-hand vehicles to enable the teams to deliver aid right into the hands of the most vulnerable, the traumatised, and other needy people. The need is still high so please continue to drop off what items you can at the 2 collection hubs in the Circuit i.e. Christ Church in Nelson and Central Church in Burnley. Your support is truly appreciated by many people in the Ukraine.
