Recently due to a Winter Essentials grant we have been providing new duvets, covers, portable fan heaters, hot water bottles, tin openers, throws, socks and hats. Regular surveys with our visitors have shown what they really need - not necessarily what we think they need! Our numbers attending are steadily increasing, but support is rising accordingly. We thank everyone for their prayers that we can continue to provide for those struggling to meet the rising costs incurred with daily life.
